MEETING WITH THE AUTHOR DAVID HARRIS: "ANTISEMITISM: WHAT EVERYONE NEEDS TO KNOW"

Antisemitism is the world's oldest social disease. Thought by many to be in remission—at least in the West—it is once again surging. Why now? And, most importantly, what can be done about it?

This book offers up-to-date analysis of antisemitism, exploring both its historical roots and modern expressions.

David Harris serves as Exec. Vice Chair of the Institute for the Study of Global Antisemitism and Policy, and served as CEO of the American Jewish Committee (1990-2022). He has, over five decades, championed human rights, Holocaust remembrance, interfaith dialogue, and the fight against antisemitism, while helping rescue Ethiopian and Soviet Jewry and expand Israel's diplomatic reach.


